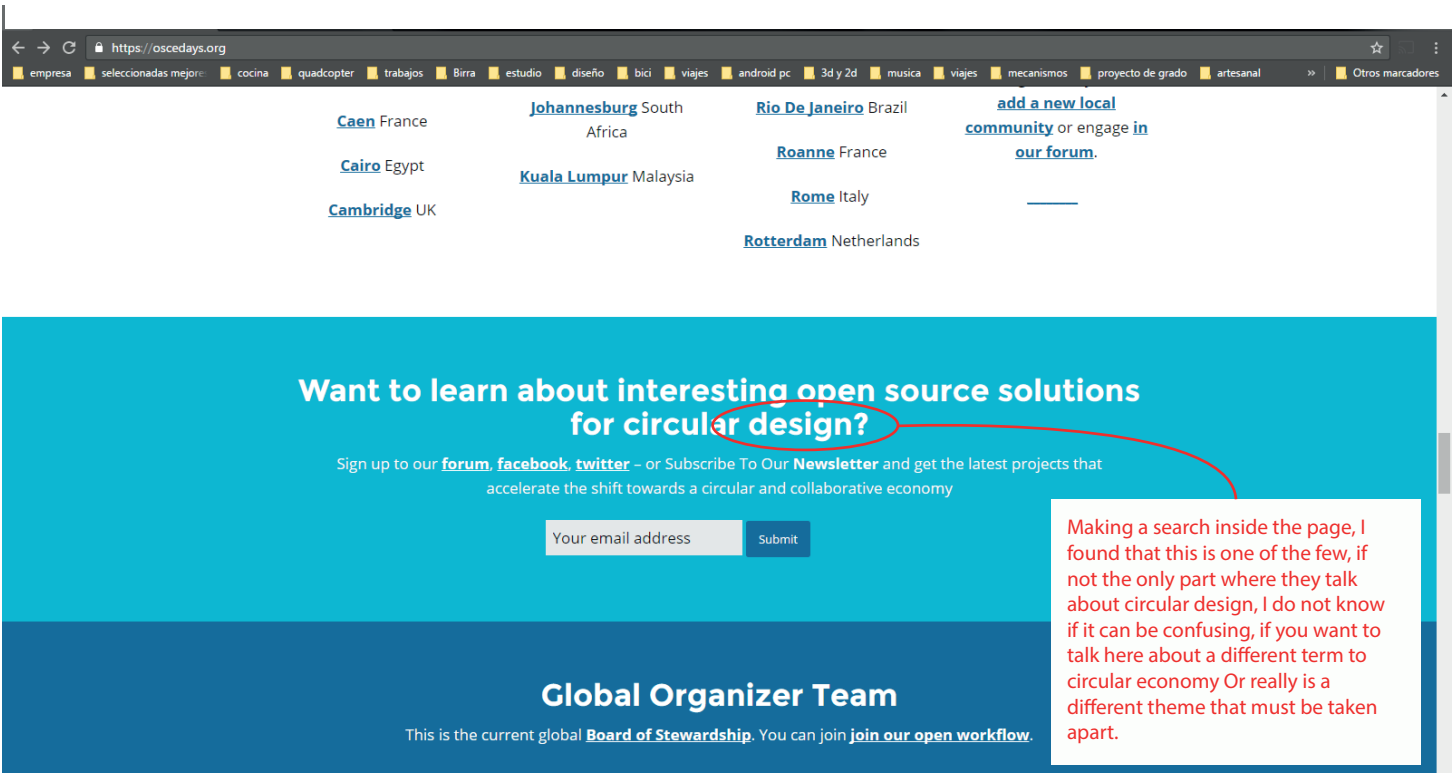
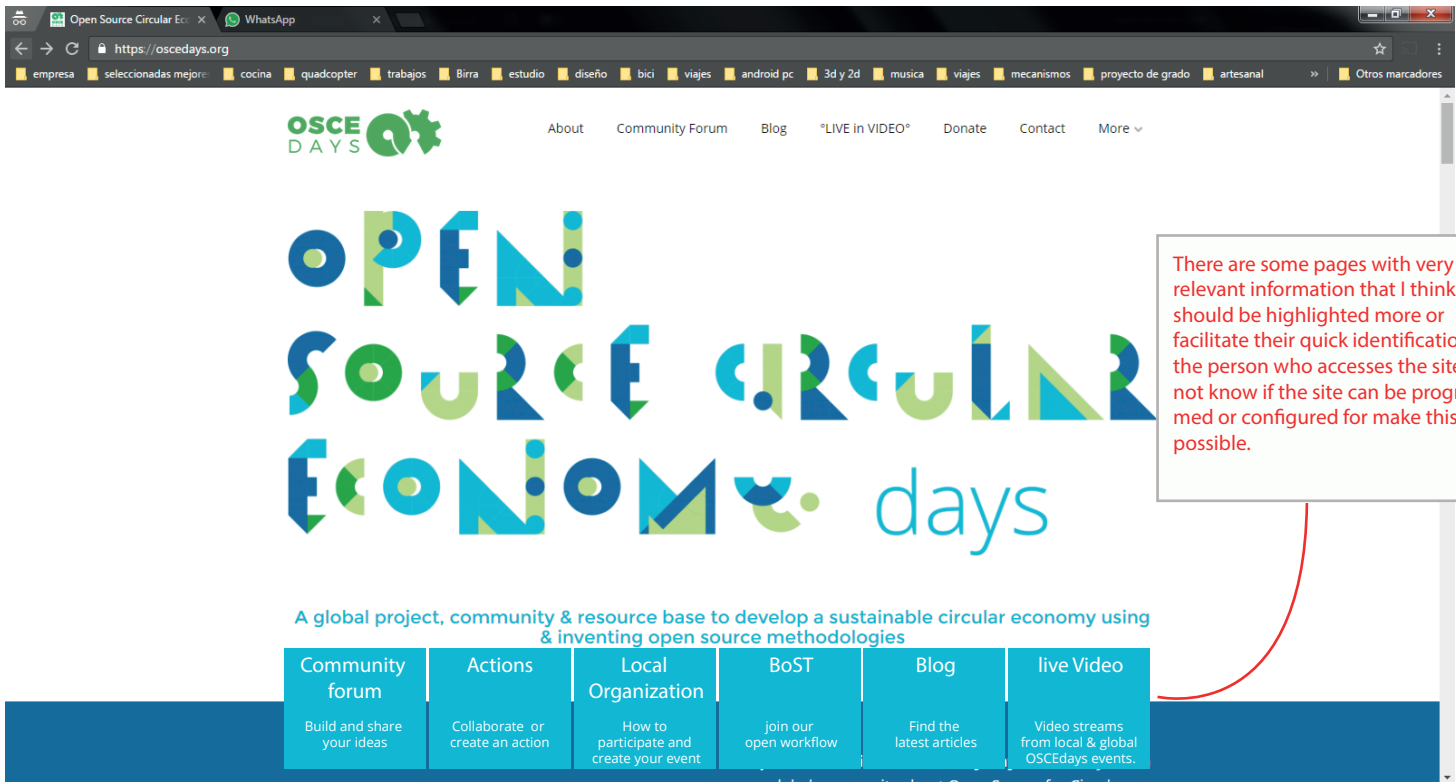

SET UP A LOCAL ACTIVITY

OSCEdays is an open and distributed community exploring Open Source for Circular Economy. One of the most important ways to connect globally and locally is **to enable and invite** people to **organize local events**. In the past 2 years almost 100 local groups in 100 cities got engaged.

Organize a local event and add a local community. Events are a good way to test something new and invite people to it. OSCEdays provides a growing [list of ACTIONS](#) = things you can do and play with at a local event. There are also [several practical materials](#) you can use to set up a local event. Below you can find more information about how to set up an event.

Participation FAQ

What Kind Of Event?

There is **no minimum or maximum size** for a local event. It can be very small with just some friends meeting for an afternoon to do something or very large with activities for several days or weeks.

Look at the [OSCEdays ACTION protocols](#) to get inspiration for activities at your event. All of these ACTIONS will make you use and build open resources to push the building of a global circular economy. Just take some of them and invite people to facilitate and implement them locally.

These pages are very complete, the information presented explains in depth all aspects of the OSCE events, but I consider that adjustments could be made in the way the information is presented so that it is much easier to take advantage of by those who want to participate or create Their events.

In some parts the information is not very clear (it is very open... sorry) on how to carry out the event or how to carry it out.

You have to look at several sites to complete and get an idea of all the relevant information (OSCEdays ACTION protocols, several practical materials, read this participation guide already in our forum, adaptable graphic design files) and perhaps could be centralized.

Another thing that could be done is to deliver a package with everything necessary to carry out an event and a very clear summary. If you want to drill down, then complete that information with other sites and if you still have questions help yourself with the category you have already in the forum, **but let's say that the order and complexity of the information can be incremental.**
