

... is an economical system in which maximal value and utility is extracted from resources and products by using regenerative processes and continuous loops that avoid waste and preserve natural capital.

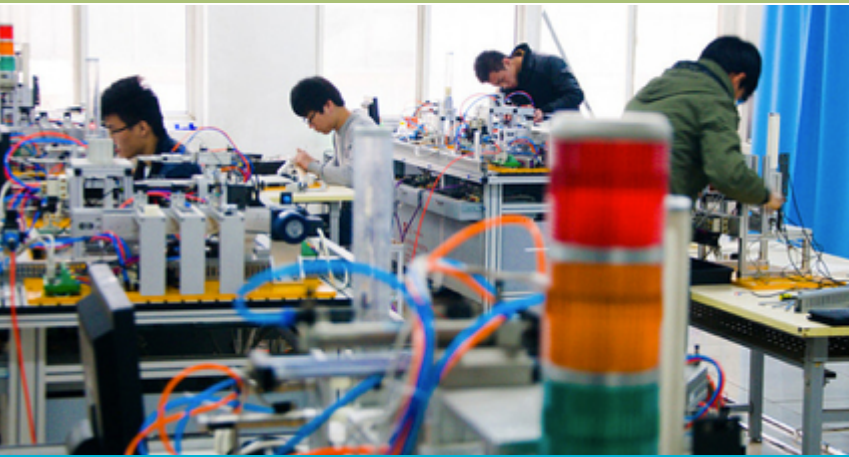

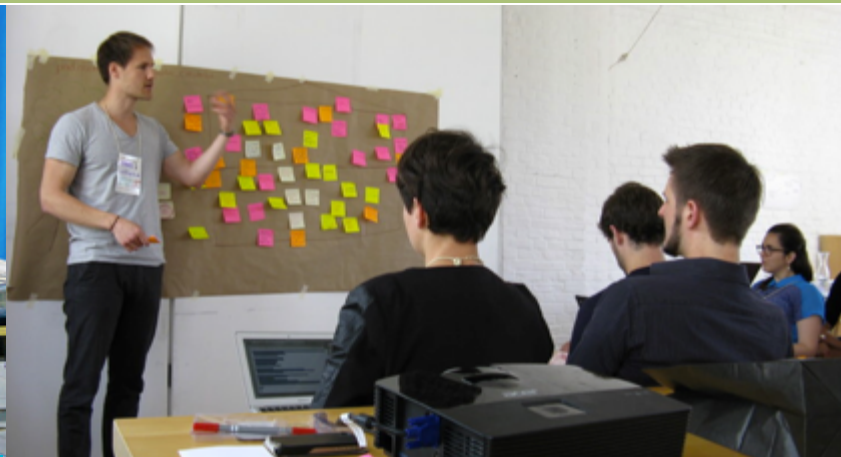
